

RULES FOR PARTICIPANTS

- (a) The 2018 International Letter Writing competition shall be open to school going children up to 15 years of as on 31.03.2018.
- (b) The age of participants is to be certified by the school authorities where the participant is studying.
- Date by which participants should declare their

 to CPMG/PMG /School Principal
- (d) Date and time of the 'on the spot competition'. 07.01.2018 (Sunday) 10.00 to 11.00hrs.
- (e) The participants will make their own arrangements to reach the venue of the competition. The Department / schools will provide the answer books for the competition to the children but they will bring their own pen/ pencil etc.
- (f) All the candidates shall be required to apply in person to the Chief Postmaster General / Postmaster General/ School Principal in duplicate. Both copies must have a passport size photograph of the candidate affixed on them.
- (g) The participants will apply for participation in the competition along with three passport size photographs in the following format on plain paper.

IMPORTANT:-All the particulars as mentioned above including the full name and address of the participant should appear on the first page of the Answer Book also. Entries, which do not furnish all relevant details, would not be considered valid.

DEPARTMENTAL INSTRUCTIONS

- (1) The evaluation of all entries including entries in regional language will be done at the Circle level by the examiners selected by the Circle Heads from amongst the officers of the Department working in the Circle.
- (2) In case, a circle receives entries in regional languages other than the regional language of the circle and it is not feasible to get such entries evaluated /translated such entries may be sent to the appropriate Circle with the request that such entries may be evaluated/translated, under intimation to the Directorate.
- After evaluation, best three (3) entries from each circle may be forwarded to the Directorate. In case there are any regional entries amongst the best three (3) entries, such entries may be translated into English and such regional entries along with its English translation may be sent to the Directorate. Rest of the entries may be kept in a regional language may be retained at the circle headquarter.
- (4) The examiners may be instructed to give weight while evaluating the entries to:
 - a) Correctness of language
 - b) Coherence –logical development
 - c) Originality of the ideas
 - d) Style of writing
 - e) Theme; and
 - f) Format of the letter
- (5) It is to be specifically ensured that no invigilator is posted at a Centre where his /her son/ daughter near relative etc., is appearing.
- (6) The duration of the competition will be one hour and the maximum marks allotted are 100 (One hundred).
- (7) To give publicity to the Letter Writing Competition, The Circles may release advertisements in local newspapers through DAVP. The Circles may also print suitable posters and take other publicity measurers in the light of their experience in the past. The copies of the advertisements can also be sent to the local State level educational institutions for better response.
- The 2018 International Letter-Writing Competition for Young People will be held strictly in accordance with the following time schedule:

2	Date and time of the 'on the spot competition'.	07.01.2018(Sunday) 10.00 to 11.00 hours

9. All the candidates shall be required to apply in person to the Chief Postmaster General/ Postmaster General/ School Principal in duplicate. While one copy of the application form may be retained for office records, the second copy duly receipted shall function as the Hall permit. Both copies must have a passport size photograph of the candidate affixed on them.

All the applications and hall permits received from the participants are to be preserved in the offices of CPMG / PMG School Principal till the process of selection of the prize-winning entries and distribution of awards is complete.
